

Landscaping Contractor Registration Application Enclosure Form (Regulations & Informational)

- Do not deposit clippings in the street, on sidewalks or in rear yard swales or drainage ditches.
- Remove all debris from the property from landscape work.
- Park vehicles & trailers on the proper side of the street, use reflective cones at the rear of the vehicles & trailers.
- Work hours are Mon – Fri 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday operations are to be avoided if possible.

Service Dept - Leaf Pick-up

The Service Department provides curbside leaf pickup beginning mid-October and will continue through early December. As you begin autumn cleanup, please keep the following in mind:

- Leaves should be raked to the tree lawn and placed as close to the street as possible.
- Branches, twigs and grass may not be mixed with your leaf piles as they will clog and damage our equipment.
- Leaves should not be placed in street circles. Please keep them on the tree lawn.
- Please place leaf piles away from mailboxes and light poles.
- There is no set schedule for leaf pickup. We will attempt to get to each street, once a week, every week.
- There will be no spring leaf collection.

The Village is not responsible for branch and/or log pick-up provided by a professional tree service company.

Tree trimmings, from the resident's yard, can be brought to the Service Department for disposal. Please have the resident call and notify us that you will be coming. 440.442.5506

Please do not "volcano" mulch the trees (the practice of putting mulch high against the tree trunk). It can cause the death of the tree. Generally, mulch is 2-3" deep, not touching the tree trunk, and extending to the drip line of the tree.
