**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE  
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND TO EXPEND FUNDS  
TO AMERICAN FIREWORKS  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000.00  
FOR THE 2022 FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATION  
FIREWORKS DISPLAY**

WHEREAS, based upon recommendation, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to employ a qualified fireworks contractor for the Fourth of July Celebration for 2022; and

WHEREAS, Shane McAviney, the Director of Parks and Recreation of Mayfield Village, reviewed proposals from fireworks contractors that were received in response to a request for proposals;

WHEREAS, American Fireworks submitted a proposal for \$20,000.00 for the 2022 Fireworks Display; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the proposals, Shane McAviney recommends that American Firework's proposal be accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield, upon the recommendation of the Director of Parks and Recreation, wishes to accept American Firework's proposal and enter into contract for the Fourth of July Celebration fireworks display for 2022.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby accepts the proposal of American Fireworks and approves and authorizes an expenditure of \$20,000.00 to American Fireworks for the Fourth of July Celebration fireworks display for 2022.

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to enter into contract with American Fireworks for the Fourth of July Celebration fireworks display for 2022.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meeting of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it authorizes a time sensitive contract for providing Village services and programs. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
