Council President Schutt stated, good evening everyone. Today is Monday, June 7, 2021. WHEREAS, John's colleagues know him as a calm, steady co-worker and friend who takes pride in his work and is always ready to lend support or help when needed. We will miss his quiet good humor and kindness.

Building Commissioner John Marrelli is hereby recognized and thanked for 17 years of dedication and commitment to Mayfield Village. On behalf of residents, business owners, department heads and staff, we congratulate him on the occasion of his retirement and wish him continued success and many years of health and happiness spending time with his lovely wife Meg, their children and grandchildren.

Mayor Bodnar stated, congratulations Dan and welcome aboard. We look forward to working with you.


Mr. Russell stated, thank you Mayor. I appreciate it. I look forward to working with everybody also.


ADJOURNMENT
