

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL  
MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO  
Monday, June 12, 2023 – 7:00 p.m.  
Mayfield Village Reserve Hall-Mayfield Village Civic Center**

The Council of Mayfield Village met in Special Session on Monday, June 12, 2023 at Mayfield Village Reserve Hall. Council President Schutt called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council President Schutt stated, please let the record reflect that Councilman Arndt is excused from this evening's meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was given.

- **First Reading of Resolution 2023-39**, entitled, "An emergency resolution accepting an Ohio EPA Recycle Ohio Grant and authorizing Mayfield Village to enter into an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency 2023 Community and Litter Grant Agreement with the Ohio EPA for the purchase of two (2) new leaf collection trailers." Introduced by Mayor Bodnar (Service Department)

Mr. Murphy, seconded by Mrs. Juncisek, made a motion to suspend Resolution No. 2023-39.

Mr. Meyers stated, I would just personally like to thank you Frank, Michael and Lenny for what you did here in writing this grant. Most people don't pay attention. I really appreciate that.

Mr. Stupczy stated, thank you.

Council President Schutt asked, any other discussion or comments?

Mr. Wynne stated, yes, for budgeting purposes for this year we had budgeted for one leaf machine for \$100,000 and now as a result of the grant application, we can get two new machines for \$50,000, half the price of what we had in the budget.

Council President Schutt stated, Mr. Stupczy would you like to add anything else to the discussion on the trailers?

Mr. Stupczy stated, I am mostly here if you have any questions. I would like to apologize for the need for a Special Council Meeting, but I really appreciate it. We are excited about getting the trailers. Thank you.

Mr. Williams asked, what is a trailer? It picks up the leaves?

Mr. Stupczy replied, yes. It sucks up the leaf piles. It's a big box that goes behind the truck and acts like a vacuum and picks up the leaf piles. The preliminary cost for each of those was between \$105,000 and \$120,000. Presently we run on a 2002 machine and a 2007 machine and a 1987 machine. Every once in a while for the last couple trips out it dies on us. We are in dire need of one new machine at least if not two.

There was none.
