Income Tax Collections

For the month of April 2023, income tax collections, net of refunds of approximately \$16,000, totaled \$801,352. This amount is \$66,079 below our 2022 collections of \$867,431 and \$819,876 below our 2021 collections of \$1,621,228. On a year-to-date basis, income tax collections for 2023, net of refunds of approximately \$131,000, totaled \$3,786,842. This amount is \$178,571 below our 2022 collections of \$3,965,413 and \$5,414,569 below our 2021 collections of \$9,201,411. Two charts, one showing monthly income tax collections since 2016 and one showing current year-to-date collections compared to total annual collections since 2013, are attached to this report.

Year-to-date income tax collections of \$3,786,842 also represent approximately 42% of our 2023 budget of \$9,000,000.

Income tax collections are derived from three sources: employee withholdings remitted by employers; direct payments from individuals, and net profit tax from businesses. The following chart shows a threeyear comparison of income tax collections by source at April 30th:

General Fund

At April 30, 2023, General Fund revenues totaled \$5,586,034. This amount is \$327,552 **above** our 2022 revenues of \$5,258,482 and \$4,470,950 **below** our 2021 revenues of \$10,056,984. This amount also represents approximately 40% of our 2023 budget of \$13,808,300.

At April 30, 2023, General Fund expenditures totaled \$4,956,624. This amount is \$205,120 **below** our 2022 expenditures of \$5,161,744 and \$154,834 **below** our 2021 expenditures of \$5,111,458. This amount also represents approximately 26% of our 2023 budget of \$19,027,900.

For the month of April 2023, our General Fund balance **increased** by \$109,841. On a year-to-date basis, our General Fund balance has **increased** by \$629,410 and is \$42,596,687 at April 30, 2023. This compares to \$41,967,277 at December 31, 2022, \$41,125,503 at December 31, 2021 and \$33,623,790 at December 31, 2020. Keep in mind that the months of February and March each year represent the Village's heaviest tax collection months due to the payment of company bonuses. The monies we collect now will be used throughout the year to fund Village operations.

Actual vs. Budget Comparison - All Funds

Total Village receipts at April 30, 2023 are \$6,489,606. This represents approximately 42% of our 2023 budget of \$15,589,400. A schedule and pie chart reflecting receipts by major classification are attached to this report.

Total Village expenditures at April 30, 2023 are \$5,819,779. This represents approximately 23% of our 2023 budget of \$25,590,144. A schedule and pie chart reflecting expenditures by major classification are attached to this report.

Debt

Total outstanding debt at April 30, 2023 is \$2,386,956 (detail schedule attached).

Miscellaneous

Our total cash/fund balance position at April 30, 2023 is \$52,493,504. Of this amount, \$32,724,030 is invested with Star Ohio and \$12,720,837 is invested in certificates of deposit and government securities of various amounts maturing monthly over a 60-month time period.

Monies included in our 2023 budget for Capital Equipment/Improvements/Infrastructure projects total \$5,563,000. At April 30, 2023, funds totaling \$855,870 have been spent and/or encumbered towards the cost of these projects (detail schedule attached).

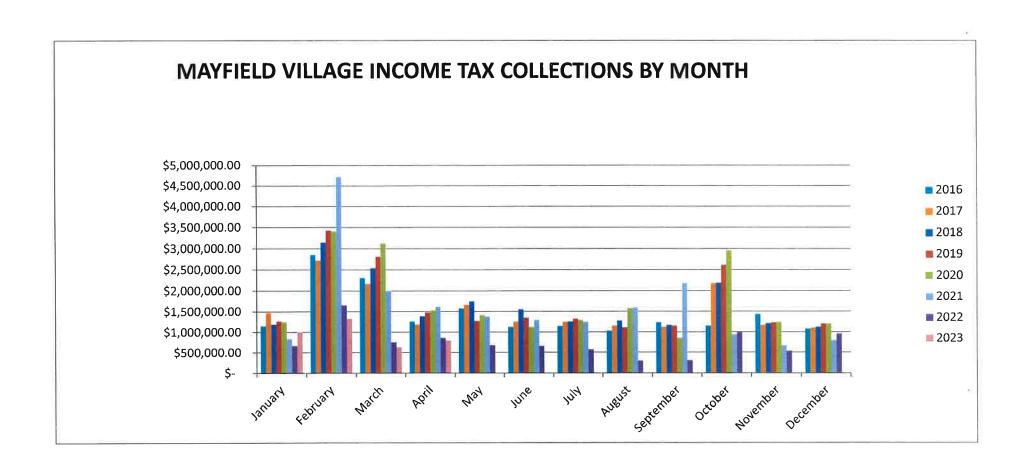
