AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO PARTICIPATE IN A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH SOURCEWELL

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 9.48(B)(2) permits political subdivisions of the State of Ohio to participate in joint purchasing programs operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivisions in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership; and

WHEREAS, the Village Finance Director hereby requests authority in the name of Mayfield Village to become a member of the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program for the Village's purchase of machinery, material supplies or other articles required by various Village departments; and

WHEREAS, future purchases made by the Village through Sourcewell shall be exempt from competitive bidding requirements and will be at costs competitively bid by Sourcewell; and

WHEREAS the Council deems it necessary and in the best interest to the health safety and welfare of all Village residents to participate in the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Mayor, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 9.48(B)(2), is hereby granted the authority to participate in the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles required for the efficient and cost-effective operation of various Village departments.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The Mayor and/or her designee agrees to and shall be bound by the terms and conditions, as Sourcewell may prescribe, for membership in the cooperative purchasing program.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to directly pay Sourcewell and or its vendors pursuant to contracts with said vendors for items purchased through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place

in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides for necessary authority to enter into contracts for maintenance and other governmental responsibilities of Mayfield Village. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
