

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO DESIGNATE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT AS REVENUE REPLACEMENT AND TO OBLIGATE, APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND THOSE FUNDS TO PAY FOR WAGES OF SAFETY FORCES IN 2024

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) which was signed into law March 11, 2021, established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (“SLFRF”); and

WHEREAS, \$350 billion was appropriated to be used by state, local, and Tribal governments across the country to support their response to and recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Village received \$350,949.78 in ARPA funds – half in 2021 and half in 2022; and

WHEREAS, these funds are required to be obligated no later than December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to designate those funds as revenue replacement and to obligate, appropriate and expend those funds to pay for wages of safety forces in 2024.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. \$350,949.78 of Police and Fire wages be obligated and transferred from the General Fund to the ARPA Fund where they are to be appropriated and expended for the payment of wages of safety forces in calendar year 2024.

SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission upon passage and signature by the Mayor and President of Council.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect after adoption and at the earliest time allowed by law.
