Re: Asphalt Rejuvenation Program Reimbursement

Dear Mayor Bodnar and Council,

At the September 9th, 2024 Council Caucus meeting, Council Member Murphy asked me how much of the cost of this program will be reimbursable from the Cuyahoga Countywide Preventative Maintenance Program. I stated that the full amount of the \$28,000.00 would be reimbursable. That statement was incorrect. The County will only reimburse the amount spent on County roadways which for this year's program is approximately \$16,000. The remaining \$12,000 is to rejuvenate Village owned roadways and will be the Village's responsibility to pay.

The County roadways include Highland Road, White Road and Ridgebury Blvd.

The Village roadways include Seneca Road, Metro Park Drive and Zorn Lane.

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,000.00
TO PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGY INC. FOR
ASPHALT REJUVENATION AS PART OF THE CUYAHOGA COUNTYWIDE
PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, based upon recommendation, it was deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to perform periodic and annual maintenance on roadways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, as part of that maintenance, the Village entered into a Master Cooperative Agreement for Preventative Maintenance Services with Cuyahoga County for the Village to participate in the Cuyahoga Countywide Preventative Maintenance Program; and

WHEREAS, at this time, the Village Engineer has recommended that certain roadways in the Village, in coordination with the Cuyahoga Countywide Preventative Maintenance Program, be improved with an asphalt rejuvenation process.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby authorizes an expenditure to Pavement Technology Inc. for the asphalt rejuvenation of certain roadways in the Village in coordination with the Cuyahoga Countywide Preventative Maintenance Program in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00. Pavement Technology is providing this work based upon the State Contract for same or similar materials and services (Contract ID No. DOT101L25-14).

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary so that the completion of the roadway maintenance asphalt rejuvenation process may begin as soon as possible and before changes in the weather would delay the process. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than

five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
