 2. Parkview Playground - Annual contracted inspection. Patch and reseal surface.
 3. Softball Fields - Outsource annual field maintenance
 4. Soccer Fields - Replace goals as needed. Continue annual Field Maintenance Plan
 5. Tennis, Bocce, and Volleyball Courts - Annual inspection and address issues when identified

2. Programming and Special Events

- A. Continue to restructure programs and special events to meet the changing needs of the community while addressing safety guidelines.
- B. Expand Senior programming with outdoor programs.
- C. Create a recycling program in the parks.

3. Budgeting

- A. Continue to improve staffing, understanding overall budgeting for events, programs, and/or facilities.

4. Personal Development

- A. Improve staff skills through continuing education seminars such as OPRA, NPRA, and AB.
- B. Work to improve overall internal and external communication within the Department.
- C. Work on continuing to improve the staff technology skills.

5. Customer Service/Community Relations

- A. Develop and implement customer service policies at Parkview Pool through a new management team.

6. Marketing

- A. Continue to expand our social and electronic media market through Facebook, email, and Google.

Parkview Pool



Each year, the Parkview Pool staff strives to provide Village residents and pool guests with a safe, clean, and enjoyable experience. The summer of 2024 not only saw a return to pre-pandemic gate attendance but also surpassed it, with an expanded Learn to Swim program. Over 23,000 guests visited Parkview Pool, seeking relief from one of the warmest summers on record.

Staff training began in early spring and continued throughout the summer, ensuring safety in and around the water for both guests and employees. Parkview lifeguards performed eight rescues, a decrease from the 19 rescues recorded in 2023. Veteran head guards and managers assisted with swim tests and swimmer management, helping to identify weaker swimmers and move them to appropriate pool areas. This proactive approach contributed to fewer rescues. Weekly in-service trainings and skills checks ensured all staff remained rescue-ready.

This year, four maintenance staff members earned certification as American Red Cross Shallow Water Lifeguards, providing an additional layer of surveillance. Alongside the Mayfield Village Service Department, Parkview Pool maintenance staff helps care for the entire Parkview Recreation Area, including restrooms, baseball and soccer fields, tennis and bocce courts, and the Green Way Trail. Their certifications also enhanced safety throughout the park, enabling staff to offer first aid when needed while performing their daily duties.

The Parkview Pool Learn to Swim program continues to grow, with nearly 800 participants, ranging from 6 months old to adults, learning water safety through group and private lessons. In addition to teaching swimming, Parkview Pool staff also trains individuals to become lifeguards and Learn to Swim instructors. This year, American Red Cross instructors certified 18 lifeguards, 6 Water Safety Instructors, and 3 Lifeguard Instructors. All aquatic staff also renewed and updated their CPR/AED, First Aid, and lifeguarding skills.

To some Parkview Pool guests, it might seem like the high school and college students sitting in the lifeguard stands have an easy job. However, other guests have witnessed Parkview Pool lifeguards in action when the sound of a whistle suddenly interrupts an otherwise relaxing day. At that moment, the facility's Emergency Action Plan (EAP) springs into motion, and each staff member plays a critical role. Everyone moves—managers, guards on break, and, most importantly, the guard who has just entered the water to perform a rescue. This year, four lifeguards performed a total of eight rescues. Fatima Sardo-Longo had the distinction of making the first rescue of the season, while Aidan Arth and Reese Durosoko each performed two rescues, and Mackenzie Pentosa completed one.

Parkview Pool has adapted Dean Cain's famous quote, "Real heroes don't wear capes," to include, "They work at Parkview Pool." Below are this year's capeless heroes.

Residents have also expressed their gratitude for the staff's dedication and the facility's well-maintained environment. Patti Fioritto, a regular morning swimmer, shared her appreciation:

"On behalf of all the morning swimmers, I wanted to take a moment to let you know how much we all appreciate that Parkview Pool was open early every morning through Labor Day. The pool and diving well were always filled with many grateful, happy lap swimmers and both shallow and deep water exercisers.

Kudos to AnneMarie and her guards—Mike, Steven, Nathaniel, and Rex—and to Gary for keeping the pool crystal clear and warm!

We are fortunate to have such a beautiful and well-maintained facility in Mayfield Village. The morning swimmers are a happy, dedicated group of people that show up every day and are truly grateful for the opportunity to be at Parkview Pool. We thank you and look forward to next summer!"

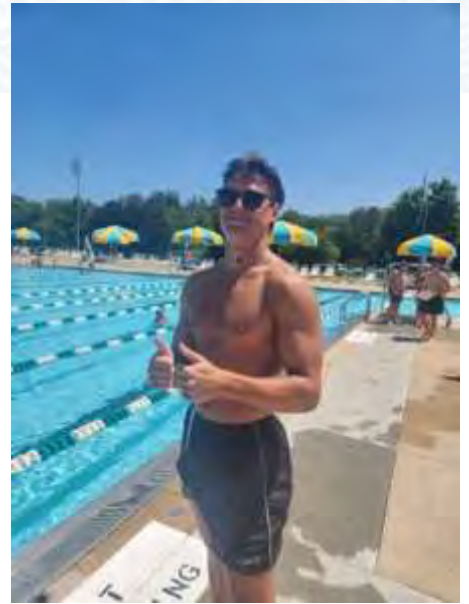

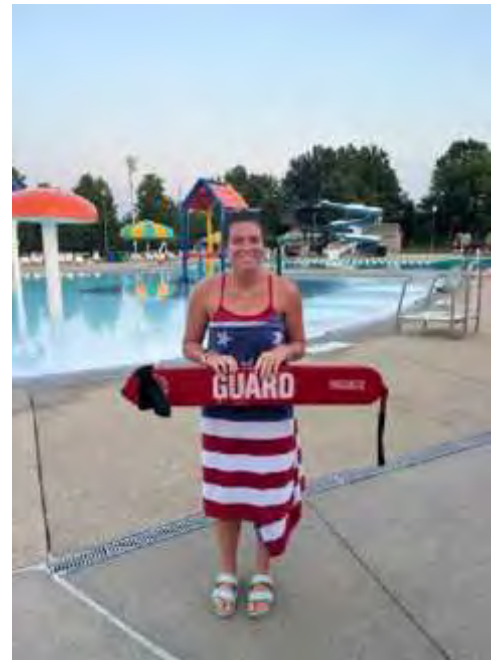

Youth Sports Programming

Mayfield Village Parks and Recreation has continued to work with Rookie Sports Club for 2024. Rookie Sports offers a variety of instructional youth sports programs for ages 3-12. Soccer, Tennis, Tball, Coach Pitch Baseball and Basketball are very popular and offered generally for the 3-6 year olds. Golf is also offered which is programmed for 5-12 year olds. During the summer, Rookie Sports Club also offers one week sports/specialty camps. This year the camps ran up to age 12 and include soccer, golf, volleyball, flag football, cheerleading, track, multisport and even Junior Ninja and Superhero Camps. The Rookie Sports Club introduced a preschool Physical Education program in 2023 which runs indoor during the cooler months. Because of the initial success of the program Mayfield Village Parks and Recreation Department continues to offer this Rookie preschool program. Almost every single one of these programs fill quickly and Mayfield Village Parks and Recreation Department often has a waiting list. Approximately 560 individual children are enrolled in these programs this year and many of them participate in more that one of the sports and more than one season.

The Rookie Sports Club organization offers a superb experience for these kids. The partnership between Mayfield Village parks and Recreation and this organization continues to benefit both individual entities as well as the local communities



Youth Sports Evaluation

Mayfield Village Parks and Recreation is excited to continue our successful partnership with Rookie Sports Club in 2024. This collaboration has allowed us to provide a wide variety of instructional youth sports programs for children ages 3-14, creating valuable opportunities for skill development, physical activity, and fun.

Rookie Sports Club offers an impressive lineup of popular programs, including Soccer, Tennis, T-ball, Coach Pitch Baseball, Flag Football, and Basketball, primarily catering to our youngest athletes, ages 3-6. Additionally, we offer a specialized Golf program tailored for children ages 5-12, ensuring that kids of all interests can find a sport they love.



During the summer, Rookie Sports Club expands its offerings with one-week sports and specialty camps that cater to kids up to age 15. These camps include Soccer, Golf, Volleyball, Multisport, and even unique options like Junior Ninja and Superhero Camps, providing a diverse and engaging experience for participants.

It was a spectacular Mayfield Village Summer Camp season! Mayfield Village Summer Camp for K-7th graders ran from June 10-August 2. Out of those 8 weeks, they were broken into two week sessions. Each session was full with 75 campers which is an increase of five additional campers compared to last summer. It is difficult to increase enrollment size as staff must also be considered in terms of

space on the busses used for transportation and for comfort within Parkview Pool Pavilion which is the home base of this outdoor camp. This summer we had 113 total children attending summer camp and many of them attended multiple sessions.

Camp staff was exceptional this year; the best it has ever been. The overall Director was Elizabeth Pona with John Catalano, Cassidy Lewis and John Razzante as Co-Directors. Three of these individuals are teachers in Mayfield City Schools and one in a neighboring district. The entire camp staff demonstrated strong leadership and communication skills. They all worked together as a team and conducted themselves in a very positive manner. The positive feedback received from parents in regards to staff (and the entire camp as a whole) was tremendous. Field trips and swimming at Parkview Pool continue to be the favorite activities among campers. Playing at Parkview Playground is another highly anticipated activity for campers. Field trips occurred once a week for younger group and sometimes twice a week for the older campers. The Mayfield Village Summer Camp visited Parkview Pool nearly every day and also played on the playground every day. Occasionally vendors were brought in and the campers delighted in receiving glitter tattoos and playing in the bubbles provided during the foam party towards the end of the camp season. With the camp's home base at Parkview Playground, the campers and staff had access to all of the athletic facilities at Parkview.

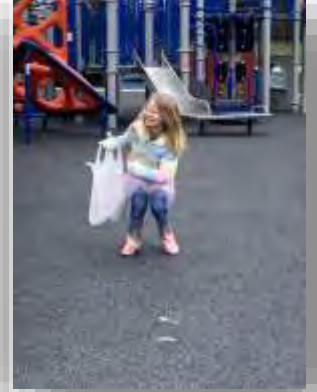

Parkview Pool

Parkview Pool offers a variety of programs for toddlers through Seniors. The facility is outstanding with lanes for lap swimming, learn to swim, open swim or competitive activities, and open swimming. The facility also includes separate competitive diving well (12'8" deep), a corkscrew waterslide, a 0-42-inch depth play area with various water toys, a concession stand, men's and women's locker rooms, and shade structures.

Parkview Softball Complex & Soccer Fields

The Parkview Softball Complex is located at 425 North Commons Blvd. and includes three softball diamonds and two large soccer fields plus three mini fields. For more information, contact the Recreation Department at 440.461.5163.

The Grove

The Grove is our newest Amphitheatre/green space in the heart of Mayfield Village's Greenway Corridor. Located on 3 acres just north of Parkview Pool, with easy access to the Greenway Trail System, the Wetlands, the new Library, the North Chagrin Reservation, and Mayfield Village's softball and soccer fields, The Grove is surrounded by trees creating a secluded commons in the center of our Village park system.

Parkview Playground

Located at 425 North Commons Blvd., boasts a large toddler/youth playground that includes state-of-the-art playground equipment, a rubberized play surface, and a pavilion that is available for rental by school district residents. For rental information, contact the Recreation Department at 440.461.5163.

Wiley Park

Located at 610 SOM Center Road offers a volleyball court and bocce court. Wiley Park also has a pavilion with a wood-burning fireplace that is available for rent. Firewood is provided with the rental of the pavilion. For rental information, contact the Recreation Department at 440.461.5163.

The Bruce G. Rinker Greenway

Greenways are corridors of protected open space managed for conservation and recreational purposes. Trails are paths used for walking, bicycling, and other forms of recreation.

Parkview Tennis and Pickle Ball Courts

The Mayfield Village Recreation Department has three tennis courts with one lined for Pickle Ball. These courts have lights and are located at the Parkview Recreation Area located off of S.O.M. Center Road. The courts are programmed through the Recreation Department. There is at least one court available for open play throughout the week. In 2024, four additional pickle ball courts will be added.

Parkview Bocce Ball Courts

The Mayfield Village Recreation Department has 4 Bocce Courts with lights available at the Parkview Recreation Area located off of S.O.M. Center Road. The courts are programmed through the Recreation Department. There is at least one court available for open play throughout the week.

Parkview Sand Volleyball

The Mayfield Village Recreation Department has two sand volleyball courts located next to the Soccer Complex Pavilion. The courts are programmed through the Recreation Department but are also available to the public for open play.
