AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE (YRS 2026-2040) FOR THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Mayfield Village is located within the jurisdiction of the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, the District's Policy Committee prepared and adopted a final draft of the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3734.53, 3734.54 and 3734.55; and

WHEREAS, the District provided a copy of the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update (for years 2026-2040) for ratification to each of the legislative authorities in the District (a copy can also be viewed on the District's website at cuyahogarecycles.org); and

WHEREAS, Mayfield Village must determine whether it approves the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update no later than August 10, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mayfield, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby approves the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update (yrs 2026-2040).

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby directs the Clerk to send the District a copy of this Resolution to the attention of Elizabeth Biggins-Ramer, Executive Director, Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District, 4750 East 131st Street, Garfield Hts., OH 44105.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides for the continuation of all existing programs and services offered by the District and is time sensitive. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
