AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH O'REILLY EQUIPMENT FOR UPFITTING THE F600 TRUCK WITH DUMP AND SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,249.17

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to upfit a newly-purchased Ford F600 truck with the necessary equipment for the Service Department to utilize the truck as a dump truck and for winter snow plowing (hereinafter the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, three proposals for the upfitting were received and O'Reilly Equipment's proposal in the amount of Forty-Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Nine 17/100 dollars (\$42,249.17) was the lowest and best received; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has reviewed all proposals received and recommends that O'Reilly Equipment be awarded the Project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** The Council of Mayfield Village hereby accepts and approves the proposal of O'Reilly Equipment in the amount of \$42,249.17 and the Project is hereby awarded to O'Reilly Equipment.
- **SECTION 2.** The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to enter into a contract with O'Reilly Equipment for the Project.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that the fully-equipped truck is needed to be placed in service as quickly as possible and before the fall and winter months. It shall, therefore, take effect
