**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL
TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
A&J CEMENT CONTRACTORS, INC. TO REMOVE AND REPLACE THE
DAMAGED PERMEABLE PAVERS IN THE WILEY PARKING LOT
WITH NEW PERMEABLE PAVERS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000.00**

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to repair the Wiley Parking Lot by removing damaged permeable pavers and replacing them with new permeable pavers; and

WHEREAS, proposals were solicited and three (3) proposals were received; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has reviewed the proposals and recommends that Council approve and accept the proposal of A & J Cement Contractors, Inc. in the total amount of \$30,000.00 for said project, which is the lowest bid received.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby accepts the proposal of A & J Cement Contractors, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 to remove the damaged permeable pavers in the Wiley Parking Lot and replace them with new permeable pavers.

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to enter into a contract with A & J Cement Contractors, Inc. to remove the damaged permeable pavers in the Wiley Parking Lot and replace them with new permeable pavers.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, and for the reason the repairs are necessary prior to the Winter season. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five

(5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




