**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE
TO JIM BROWN CHEVROLET, INC., dba CLASSIC CHEVROLET/GEO/BMW
FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE ENGINE IN THE
SERVICE DEPARTMENT'S 2016 GMC SIERRA 1500 TRUCK
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,222.17**

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department is in need of replacing an engine on its 2016 GMC Sierra 1500 truck; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department received two quotes for the replacement engine; and

WHEREAS, upon review of said quotes for the replacement of the engine in the 2016 GMC Sierra 1500, the quote from Jim Brown Chevrolet, Inc. dba Classic Chevrolet/GEO/BMW in the amount of \$15,222.17 is the lowest and best quote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby approves and authorizes an expenditure in a total amount not to exceed \$15,222.17 to Jim Brown Chevrolet, Inc. dba Classic Chevrolet/GEO/BMW for the purchase and installation of a new engine in the Service Department's 2016 GMC Sierra 1500 truck.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, and for the reason that it provides equipment necessary to fulfill the obligations of the Service Department as set forth in the Village of Mayfield Charter, Article V, Section 7 and Chapter 137 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mayfield. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five

(5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.


