**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND PRESIDENT OF
COUNCIL TO ENTER INTO AN ADDITIONAL
FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH EVERSTREAM AND ITS INTENDED
SUCCESSOR IN INTEREST BLUEBIRD MIDWEST, LLC DBA BLUEBIRD
FIBER FOR INTERNET AND FIBER RING MAINTENANCE SERVICE
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$33,000.00 PER YEAR**

WHEREAS, in January of 2023, Mayfield Village entered into a three-year agreement with Everstream to provide high-speed, reliable internet and connectivity service through its business-only focused fiber network for various Village locations, including maintenance of its dark fiber ring; and

WHEREAS, Mayfield Village is currently in year three of the three-year agreement with services set to expire at the end of December, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Everstream has provided a proposal for a five-year renewal agreement at a monthly rate of \$2,750.00 (\$33,000.00 annually) with 100 Mbps of bandwidth, effective January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2030; and

WHEREAS, Mayfield Village is pleased with the current level of service being provided by Everstream and wishes to enter into an additional five-year agreement with Everstream at the annual rate of \$33,000.00 to provide Mayfield Village with needed internet connectivity and fiber ring maintenance services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby accepts the proposal of Everstream and its intended successor in interest Bluebird Midwest, LLC dba Bluebird Fiber and approves and authorizes an expenditure in the annual amount of \$33,000.00 for five years for annual internet and fiber ring maintenance service.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and President of Council are hereby and herein authorized and directed to enter into a five-year service agreement with Everstream as more fully set forth in the Service Order attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to continue to provide internet and fiber ring service for Mayfield Village. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
