RE: **ODOT Repaving of SOM Center Road from SCL to Wilson Mills Road**

Dear Council President Schutt and Members of Council,

As you know, bumpy conditions exist on SOM Center Road, from Wilson Mills to the south corporate line, due to bad and broken joints. ODOT plans to mill and repave this section of roadway, at its cost, and has requested that the Village approve legislation providing consent to the Director of Transportation to do the work. A draft of that legislation is attached and will be finalized for Council's approval at the September 21, 2026 meeting. We do not have an exact date, but have been advised that the work will be done this spring.

The following is a/an Resolution enacted by Mayfield Village of Cuyahoga
(Motion/Ordinance/Resolution) (Local Public Agency)
County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

SECTION I – Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has determined the need for the described project:

Pavement PM projects throughout the district, including SOM Center Road (SR-91) from the SCL to Wilson Mills Road in Mayfield Village, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by Mayfield Village of Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

SECTION II – Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project as detailed in the LPA-ODOT-Let Agreement entered into between the parties, if applicable.

SECTION III – Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the development and construction of the above described project and shall enter into a LPA Federal ODOT Let Project Agreement, if applicable, as well as any other agreements necessary to develop and construct the Project.

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV Authority to Sign

The LPA hereby authorizes the Mayor and President of Council of said Mayfield Village to
(Signature authority) (LPA-or its division, department or agency)
enter into and execute contracts with the Director of Transportation which are necessary to develop plans for and to
complete the above-described project; and to execute contracts with ODOT pre-qualified consultants for the
preliminary engineering phase of the Project.

Upon request of ODOT, Mayor and President of Council is also empowered to execute any appropriate documents to
 (Signature authority)
 affect the assignment of all rights, title, and interests of Mayfield Village to ODOT arising from any
 (LPA)
 agreement with its consultant in order to allow ODOT to direct additional or corrective work, recover damages due
 to errors or omissions, and to exercise all other contractual rights and remedies afforded by law or equity.

SECTION V – Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION VI – Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable State and Federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VII-Emergency measure

(as applicable)

The Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to expedite the highway project and
 (Motion/Ordinance/Resolution)
 to promote highway safety. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
