**Subject:** Recommendation for Sodium Hypochlorite, Muriatic Acid and other pool chemicals for 2026

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### **Recommendation for 2026: Parkview Pool Chemical Requirements**

Mayfield Village received three proposals for the annual chemical supply required to maintain safe and proper water quality at Parkview Pool for the 2026 season. These proposals include essential pool chemicals such as liquid chlorine (sodium hypochlorite), muriatic acid, and other necessary water treatment products.

To ensure transparency and allow for a clear comparison, a detailed pricing breakdown of each proposal has been reviewed, including individual chemical costs, delivery schedules, and applicable terms and conditions from each supplier. In addition, the proposed pricing for 2026 reflects an overall decrease when compared to the Village's chemical costs in both the 2024 and 2025 pool seasons.

While EMSCO submitted the lowest overall proposal, they are unable to provide direct transfer of muriatic acid. As outlined in the attached memo from Fire Chief Carcioppolo, this limitation presents safety and operational concerns. Due to this issue, EMSCO is not recommended for the 2026 season.

Based on pricing, service capabilities, safety considerations, and the favorable reduction in costs compared to prior years, Hawkins Chemical is recommended as the supplier for Parkview Pool chemicals for 2026.

### **Additional Recommendation**

Due to the unpredictability of weather conditions and the potential for increased chemical usage throughout the season, it is further recommended that a purchase order be issued not to exceed \$32,000. This will provide the necessary flexibility to respond to additional chemical needs while maintaining uninterrupted pool operations.
