**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE  
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,000.00  
TO HAWKINS WATER TREATMENT GROUP, INC.  
FOR POOL CHEMICALS FOR PARKVIEW POOL FOR 2026**

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Mayfield Village Director of Parks and Recreation, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to purchase pool chemicals to maintain safe and proper water quality at Parkview Pool; and

WHEREAS, the Mayfield Village Director of Parks and Recreation requested proposals to supply the annual chemical needs at Parkview Pool; and

WHEREAS, three proposals were received, including one from Hawkins Water Treatment Group, Inc. in the amount of \$29,807.00 for the annual chemical needs of Parkview Pool; and

WHEREAS, although the proposal of Hawkins Water Treatment Group, Inc. was not the lowest overall, it was the only proposal that includes the ability to bulk transfer the chemicals into approved onsite storage tanks, pursuant to the hazardous materials storage and transfer procedures at Parkview Pool and in accordance with Chapter 50 of the Ohio Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, due to the unpredictability of weather conditions and the potential for increased chemical usage throughout the season, the Director of Parks & Recreation recommends that the Village accept the proposal of Hawkins Water Treatment Group, Inc. and approve an expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$32,000.00 for the annual chemical needs of Parkview Pool.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby accept the proposal and approve an expenditure not to exceed \$32,000.00 to Hawkins Water Treatment Group, Inc. for the annual chemical needs of Parkview Pool for 2026.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council, and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place

in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides for necessary services and materials to ensure that the Parks and Recreation Department and Parkview Pool are properly supported. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




