**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL
OF MARSHALL POWER EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2)
NEW EXMARK LAWN MOWERS AND THE TRADE-IN OF TWO (2) OLDER
EXMARK LAWN MOWERS FOR A CREDIT TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF
THE NEW LAWN MOWERS RESULTING IN A TOTAL EXPENDITURE IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$27,595.00**

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to purchase two (2) new ExMark lawn mowers for the Service Department to utilize to maintain Village-owned properties (hereinafter the "Mowers") and replace two (2) older ExMark lawn mowers that have reached the end of their useful life and are ready to be cycled out of service; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of Marshall Power Equipment in the amount of Twenty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Five and 00/100 dollars (\$27,595.00) for the Mowers was competitively bid through the State of Ohio joint purchasing program; and

WHEREAS, the proposal from Marshall Power Equipment includes a credit for the trade-in value of the two (2) older ExMark lawn mowers in the amount of \$3,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director recommends that the Mowers be purchased from Marshall Power Equipment for the proposed amount; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 721.15, Council deems it necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents to purchase from Marshall Power Equipment two (2) new ExMark lawn mowers and trade-in for a credit, the two (2) older ExMark lawn mowers that have reached the end of their useful life and are unfit for their intended purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO,
THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby find and determine that the two (2) older ExMark lawn mowers are unfit for continued future use by the Village, approves their trade-in to Marshall Power Equipment for a credit of \$3,500.00, and to have that amount credited to the purchase of the two (2) new ExMark lawn mowers.

SECTION 2. Based upon Section 1, above, the Council of Mayfield Village does hereby approve and authorize an expenditure in the total amount of \$27,595.00 to Marshall

Power Equipment for the purchase of two (2) new ExMark lawn mowers for the Service Department. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to purchase the Mowers from Marshall Power Equipment.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that new lawn mowers are needed to be placed in service as quickly as possible and so they are ready for the spring and summer months. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
