

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO AMEND “APPENDIX A”
TO THE BILLING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GREAT LAKES BILLING
ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THIRD PARTY AMBULANCE AND EMS BILLING,
CONSULTATION AND RELATED SERVICES TO THE VILLAGE**

WHEREAS, the Village is a provider of emergency medical service (“EMS”), ambulance and related services to patients, including the provision of the same emergency medical, ambulance and related services to patients in Gates Mills, Ohio and mutual aid to patients in neighboring jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Great Lakes Billing Associates, Inc. (“Great Lakes”) is engaged in the business of providing third party ambulance and EMS billing, consultation and related services to providers like Mayfield Village; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2025, the Village entered into a Billing Services Agreement with Great Lakes as an independent contractor to provide third party EMS and ambulance billing and related services and support to the Village on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth (Res 2025-11); and


WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Appendix A to the Billing Services Agreement to increase the Loaded Mileage rate from \$16.00 per mile to \$17.00 per mile, as well as amend the Village’s Codified Ordinance Section 1523.01(b)(4) to reflect the same change. A copy of the amended Appendix A is attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to amend Appendix A to the Billing Services Agreement with Great Lakes Billing Associate, Inc. to increase the Loaded Mileage rate from \$16.00 to \$17.00 per mile, as well as amend Village Codified Ordinance Section 1523.01(b)(4) to reflect the same change.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides necessary services to support the Village and its ambulance and EMS services. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.

APPENDIX A

Mayfield Village has established the following user fee schedule for emergency medical services provided by the Village Fire Department:

<u>Service</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Basic Life Support (BLS)	\$850.00
Advanced Life Support (ALS)	\$1,000.00
Advanced Life Support 1 (ALS1)	\$1,200.00
Loaded Mileage	\$17.00 /mile
Non-Transport	\$300.00

Mayfield Village will track and communicate mileage which shall not exceed the loaded miles from the Pickup point to the Destination by an odometer reading.
