**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO PURCHASE
TEN SETS OF FIREFIGHTER STRUCTURAL PERSONAL PROTECTIVE
EQUIPMENT FROM FIRE FORCE, INC./EAGLE EMERGENCY
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,800.**

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to provide full-time and part-time Firefighters employed by Mayfield Village with structural personal protective equipment, including helmets, hoods, gloves, turnout coats and pants; boots and flashlights (hereinafter "Turnout Gear"); and

WHEREAS, three proposals for the purchase of ten (10) sets of Turnout Gear were received and Fire Force, Inc./Eagle Emergency's proposal in the amount of Forty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$46,800.00) was the lowest and best received; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has reviewed all proposals received and recommends that the Turnout Gear be purchased from Fire Force, Inc./Eagle Emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby accepts and approves the proposal of Fire Force, Inc./Eagle Emergency in the amount of \$46,800.00 for ten sets of Turnout Gear.

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to purchase the Turnout Gear from Fire Force, Inc./Eagle Emergency.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that new part-time Firefighters have recently been hired and they need to be provided with compliant Turnout Gear as quickly as possible. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five

(5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
