**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO 2026 CHEVROLET TAHOES
WITH EMERGENCY LIGHTING UPFIT PACKAGES AND ACCESSORIES FROM
TIM LALLY CHEVROLET IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$153,665.00**

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of replacing Patrol Unit 4608, a 2020 Dodge Charger, and Patrol Unit 4613, a 2023 Dodge Charger, which units shall be declared as surplus and sold or traded-in; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended purchase of two 2026 Chevrolet Tahoes with emergency lighting upfit packages included, from Tim Lally Chevrolet in the amount of \$76,460 and \$77,205, for a total expenditure of \$153,665; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle purchases are included in this year's annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the two 2026 Chevrolet Tahoes is at a price matching State Contract No. RSI 0331643 which was competitively bid through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby approves and authorizes an expenditure in the total amount of \$153,665 to Tim Lally Chevrolet for the purchase of two 2026 Chevrolet Tahoes, with emergency lighting upfit packages included, for the Police Department, and waiving competitive bidding.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides equipment necessary to fulfill the obligations of the Police Department as set forth in the Village of Mayfield Charter and the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mayfield. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon

the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.


