Re: **Sanitary Sewer Hourly Rate Increase for 2027**

Dear President Schutt and Member of Council,

Attached is a copy of a letter from the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works informing us of the upcoming adjustment to their sanitary sewer rates, effective January 1, 2027. Attached for comparison are the new rates as well as the 2026 rates.

These rates are for the Sewer Maintenance Fund that is the subject of pending legislation to return the property tax assessment to \$4.00/ft. We are requesting a meeting with the County to discuss these rates and the projected impact on the Maintenance Fund and will report to Council following that meeting.

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming adjustment to our sanitary sewer rates, effective January 1, 2027. A schedule of the new rates is attached for your review.

The revised rates are aligned with the actual costs required to provide service to our communities.
